

WorkCover C2 Licence – Slewing Mobile Crane

TLILIC808A - Licence to Operate a Slewing Mobile Crane up to 20 tonnes

Course Overview

Slewing Mobile Crane course for WorkCover C2 photo licence covers the lifting and positioning of loads using a slewing crane up to 20 tonnes.

This course will provide all aspects of theory and practical operation of Slewing Mobile Crane in preparation for assessment. This training course relies on the participant completing structured home assignments prior and during the course.

Course Outline

- Pre operational checks
- Site / job planning
- Set up Crane
- Operate Crane
- Shut down and pack up Crane
- Special Operations

Outcome

Upon successful completion of assessment, the participant will be issued with a nationally recognised Statement of Attainment. Upon successful completion of the WorkCover Assessment, a WorkCover C2 Licence will be issued**.

Duration:

The course will take five days with training taking four full days. Assessment will be conducted on the 5th day.

Assessment

To be conducted by a WorkCover Accredited assessor.

Course Requirements

All applicants must be over 18 years of age, speak and understand English in order to participate in the WorkCover assessment. Oral assessments can be arranged for applicants with writing and reading difficulties.

Identification

Applicants must also be able to produce 100 points of Identification as per the WorkCover I.D. checklist.

**Licence Fee

A WorkCover Licence Application Fee of \$65 applies when the successful applicant lodges the paperwork at a WorkCover authorised post office. You will also be required to supply a passport sized photo for your licence. Most Post Offices can take these passport photos (approx. \$12.95 for 4 photos).
