



Apply Traffic Control Plans (Yellow Card)

Course Overview

This course provides training for staff requiring setting up and working with Traffic Control Plans (TCP).

Note This course does not qualify participants to select or modify existing TCPs or to control traffic with a Stop/Slow Bat.

Learning Outcomes

- Identify safety implications of traffic control at road works and personal responsibilities.
- Set up and Close down traffic control devices according to a nominated TCP, to OHS and legislative requirements.
- Operate a 2-way radio correctly and effectively.
- Check, clean and store equipment on completion of work and close down a TCP.

Pre-requisites

- Adequate literacy

AND HOLD

- A NSW WorkCover Construction Induction Certificate or equivalent

Duration

The duration of this course is one day (7 hours) 7.30am – 3.30pm

Validity

The Apply Traffic Control Plans Photo Identification Card is valid for three (3) years

Delivery

Classroom including practical exercise

Participants must complete knowledge and skills assessment at the end of the course.

Upon successful completion of this course, each student will be issued a certificate. Once issued with the certificate the student will be able to perform the Traffic Controller duties.

After approximately 28 days the student will then receive a wallet sized RTA photo card.

Cost
