



Elevating Work Platform Association Trained Operator Yellowcard -Transport Module (T)

Explanation

Under the Occupational Health and Safety Acts, General Duty of Care, employers must ensure the health, safety and welfare of every person in the workplace and ensure that operators be trained in the safe use of plant and equipment.

This yellowcard transport module training covers all key aspects of safe loading, transportation and unloading of access equipment on rigid and semi trailer trucks, in order to meet these General Duty of Care requirements.

The EWP Load Restraint guide used for training is in alignment with the Heavy Vehicle Driver's Handbook, the RTA and the National Transport Commission Load Restraint Guides.

Prerequisite

Applicants must have the EWPA Boomlift (BL) and Scissorlift (SL) yellowcard training. Applicants must be over 18 years old and be able to produce identification e.g. drivers licence.

The Training

The training takes approximately 3 hours. This time is approximate and will vary with the size and experience of the group.

The Outcome

An interim record of training will be issued on the day. Your yellowcard will be marked 'T' for transport and will take a few weeks to be processed and posted.

Location

Training is done on our site at Arndell Park but can also be on your site. For training on your site we require a suitable area to deliver the theory training.
