

## WorkCover LF Licence

### TLILIC2001A-Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck

#### Course Overview

This unit is based on the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work, and the unit of competency of the Transport and Logistics Training Package (TL107) covering counterbalanced and non counterbalanced type forklifts but not order picking type forklifts

Training will cover all aspects of theory and practical operation of forklifts. Elements covered during training are: Plan work, Conduct Routine Checks, Shift Loads and Shut down and secure forklift.

#### Duration

Training is conducted over 2 full days. Allow a third day for assessment.  
The final assessment is to be conducted by a WorkCover Accredited assessor.

#### Outcome

Upon successful completion a Nationally recognised Statement of Attainment is issued. Upon successful completion of the WorkCover Assessment, a WorkCover LF Licence will be issued\*\*.

#### Location

The training is conducted at WPTC facilities located in Arndell Park.  
Training can also be conducted on site with the following requirements:

- Forklift (in good order),
- sufficient yard space to operate,
- training room
- Low, medium & high level racking plus pallets with a suitable load
- Minimum of 5 persons

#### Course requirements

All applicants must be over 18 years of age, speak and understand English in order to participate in the WorkCover assessment. Oral assessments can be arranged for applicants with reading and writing difficulties. Verbal assessments incur an additional fee.

#### Identification

Applicants must also be able to produce 100 points of Identification as per the Workcover I.D. checklist.

#### Investment

\$475.00 per person (GST exempt). This fee includes the WorkCover assessment fee.

#### \*\*Licence Fee

A WorkCover Licence Application Fee of \$65 applies when the successful applicant lodges the paperwork at a Workcover authorised Post Office. You will also be required to supply a passport sized photo for your licence. Most Post Offices can take these passport photos (approx. \$12.95 for 4 photos).
