CPCCOHS1001A- Work Safely in the Construction Industry

Course Overview

This course covers the requirements for persons who are expected work on construction sites. This unit of competency ensures the participant attains the basic OHS knowledge required prior to undertaking designated work tasks within the construction industry.

1 day (7 hours)

Outcome

Upon successful completion of this course, each student will be issued a statement of attainment as part of Certificate 1 in Construction. A Workcover Statement of Training (SOT) will be issued on the day of training which will be valid for 30 days from date of issue. This SOT can be used as evidence of training until the participant receives their NSW Construction Induction Card (White Card, formerly Green Card) This will be sent out by Workcover, usually within 30 days.

Location

The training is conducted at various facilities or can also be conducted on site.

Course Requirements

Applicants must be over 14 years of age.

Identification

Applicants must also be able to produce 100 points of Identification as per the Workcover I.D. checklist.
