

WorkCover WP- Boom over 11 Metre Licence

TLILIC508A-Licence to operate a boom-type Elevating Work Platform (Boom length 11m or more)

Course Overview

This course covers the use of all types and size of trailer mounted, truck mounted and self-propelled boom type Elevating Work Platforms. Training will cover all aspects of theory and practical operation of EWP's. Elements covered during training are; pre operational checks, site/job planning, set up EWP, operate EWP and shutdown EWP.

Duration

Training is conducted over two full days. Allow a third day for assessment.
The final Assessment is to be conducted by a WorkCover Accredited Assessor.

Outcome

Upon successful completion, a Nationally recognised Statement of Attainment is issued. Upon successful completion of the WorkCover Assessment, a WorkCover WP Licence will be issued**.

Location

The training is conducted at WPTC facilities located in Arndell Park.

Training can also be conducted on site with the following requirements:

- Machine (in good order with current EWP logbook and fall arrest harness), sufficient yard space to operate, suitable training room with tables, chairs & white board
- Minimum of 5 persons

Course Requirements

All applicants must be over 18 years of age, speak and understand English in order to participate in the WorkCover assessment. Oral assessments can be arranged for applicants with reading and writing difficulties.

Identification

Applicants must also be able to produce 100 points of Identification as per the WorkCover I.D. checklist.

Investment

\$690.00 per person (GST Exempt). This fee includes the WorkCover assessment fee.
Travel costs may apply to remote onsite locations.

**Licence Fee

A WorkCover Licence Application Fee of \$65 applies when the successful applicant lodges the paperwork at a WorkCover authorised post office. You will also be required to supply a passport sized photo for your licence. Most Post Offices can take these passport photos (approx. \$12.95 for 4 photos).
